Board of Regents Support Fund: Comprehensive Briefing

Background Information

The Constitutionally established Louisiana Education Quality Trust Fund (LEQTF) has twin goals for higher education: promote academic excellence and economic development. The Louisiana Constitution authorizes the Board of Regents to achieve these goals through the following four (4) major programs:

- 1. Endowed Chairs for Eminent Scholars
- 2. Enhancement
- 3. Research and Development
- 4. Recruitment of Superior Graduate Fellows

Using interest earnings from the LEQTF, which the Treasurer allocates annually, the Board pursues fulfillment of these goals by allocating monies to public and independent campuses through the Board of Regents Support Fund (BoRSF), which currently comprises thirteen (13) subprograms within the four Constitutionally designated programs, as follows:

1. Endowed Chairs for Eminent Scholars

- c. Undergraduate Enhancement
- d. Endowed Professorships

- c. BoR/SREB Graduate Fellowships to Promote Diversity

Staff Summary
