Power-Based Violence Review Panel Members

THE SITUATION

The Power-Based Violence Review Panel was created during the 2021 Legislative Session to make recommendations relating to power-based violence and Title IX efforts on Louisiana's campuses. Its membership called for one Title IX coordinators from a public postsecondary system to participate with annual rotation between the four public higher education management systems. Due to eager engagement and input, the four systems are requesting to concurrently participate.

THE GOAL

The Power-Based Violence Review Panel's membership will be strengthened with the addition of Title IX coordinators from:

- Louisiana Community and Technical College System
- Louisiana State University System
- Southern University System
- University of Louisiana System

THE OPPORTUNITY

These system coordinators' expertise and first-hand knowledge of campus climate and student safety will allow for universal promotion of power-based violence prevention and Title IX awareness statewide while bolstering the Power-Based Review Panel's membership.
