If you have a passion for law enforcement, the criminal justice field offers a variety of career paths. A degree in Criminal Justice can open doors to careers in law enforcement, corrections, probation, and parole, or even the FBI.

In an associate program, you will gain knowledge of the legal system, learn about investigative techniques and procedures, and develop critical thinking skills. The program may include courses such as Criminology, Criminal Law, and Juvenile Delinguency.

After completing a 60-credit associate degree, you can transfer to a university that offers a bachelor's degree in criminal justice.

Transfer pathways start at a Louisiana community college.

- Complete the first 60 credits on your transfer pathway at a community college
- Earn your associate degree
- Apply to a public Louisiana university that offers a bachelor's degree in Criminal Justice
- Transfer in with a guarantee that all 60 credits will apply to your bachelor's degree
