Humanities	American History 1 and 2 World History 1 and 2 OR Western Civilization 1 and 2
Social Science	Nine credits of social science*
Fine Arts	Three credits of fine arts*
Other	Twelve credits (Choose from <i>Foreign Language Sequence, Humanities Electives, Social Science Electives</i>)*
